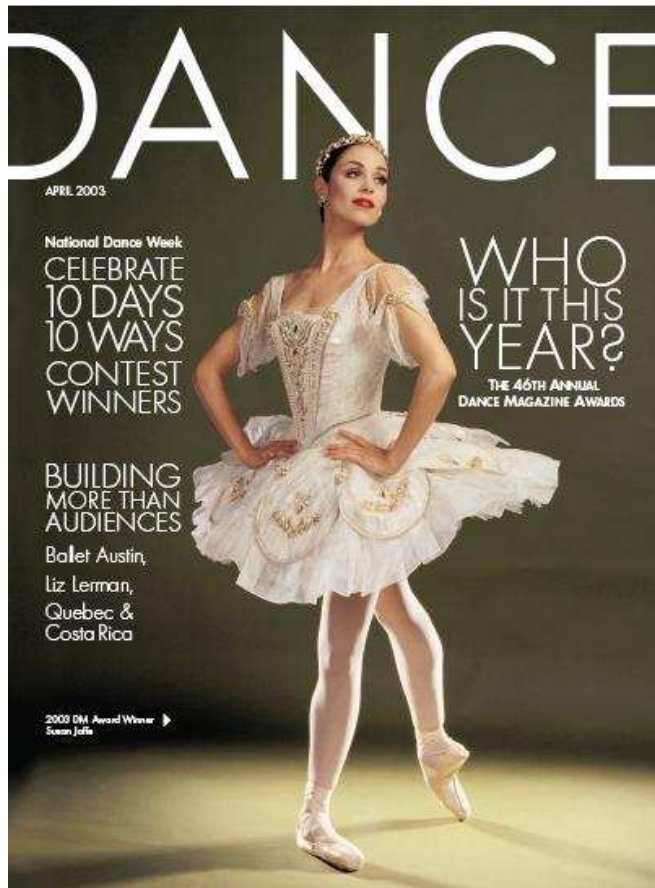




Advanced Ballet Intensive

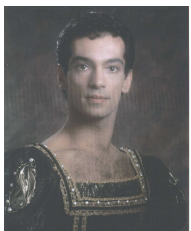

Susan Jaffe is one of the leading ballerinas of her time. She has performed in many Opera houses throughout Europe and the United States. In 1980, after training with the Maryland Youth Ballet, she joined American Ballet Theatre at the invitation of Mikhail Baryshnikov, and became well known in the dance world at an extremely young age. Jaffe has also worked with and performed the repertoire of many of the 20th century's most prominent choreographers. Her European engagements have included performances with The Royal Ballet, The Kirov Ballet, The Stuttgart Ballet, The Munich State Opera Ballet, La Scala Ballet in Milan, The Vienna State Opera Ballet, The Royal Danish Ballet, The Royal Swedish Ballet, and The English National Ballet.

One month after her retirement from American Ballet Theatre, Jaffe was invited back for the position of advisor to the Chairman and the President of the Board of Governing Trustees. She also serves as the artistic coordinator of the Youth America Grand Prix, and the Chairman of the Artists Committee of "The All-Stars," a group that helps underprivileged children develop learning skills through performance. On September 8, 2005, Jaffe & Risa Gary Kaplowitz founded the Princeton Dance & Theatre Studio in Princeton, New Jersey.



Olivier Munoz trained at the Conservatoire National De Lyon, France, International Dance Center Rosella Hightower, Cannes, France and is a Certified Professor of Dance from the French Government. He was a Principal dancer performing many major roles in companies including English National Ballet, Northern Ballet Theatre and Cleveland San Jose Ballet. As a guest artist he performed with Teatro alla Scala, Milan, Arena di Verona, Italy, Tokyo Ballet, and The Bolshoi Ballet Russia. He has coached gold medal dancers in major international ballet competitions. Mr. Munoz was the artistic director of Ballet Arkansas and is a regular guest teacher at MYB. He has won many awards including "Outstanding Teacher- YAGP," and a Silver Medal in 1981 at the Prix de Lausanne.
