Susan Jaffe is one of the leading ballerinas of her time. In 1980, after training with the Maryland Youth Ballet, she joined American Ballet Theatre at the invitation of Mikhail Baryshnikov. Jaffe has also worked with many of the 20th century's most prominent choreographers. Her European engagements have included performances with The Royal Ballet, The

Kirov Ballet, The Stuttgart Ballet, The Munich State Opera Ballet, La Scala Ballet in Milan, The Vienna State Opera Ballet, The Royal Danish Ballet, The Royal Swedish Ballet, and The English National Ballet. After her retirement from ABT, Jaffe was appointed as advisor to the Chairman and the President of the Board of Governing Trustees. In 2005, Jaffe & Risa Gary Kaplowitz founded the Princeton Dance & Theatre Studio in Princeton, New Jersey.



Olivier Munoz trained at the Conservatoire National De Lyon, France, International Dance Center Rosella Hightower and is a Certified Professor of Dance from the French Government. He was a Principal dancer with the English National Ballet, Northern Ballet Theatre and Cleveland San Jose Ballet. He has

coached gold medal dancers in major international ballet competitions and is a regular guest teacher at MYB. His awards include "Outstanding Teacher- YAGP" and a Silver Medal in 1981 at the Prix de Lausanne.
