CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Dance With Me

Adult accompanied class for 2 to 3 year olds. Music and storytelling are used to develop body awareness, discover creative expression, and explore the basic principals of movement using props and musical instruments. Adult participant may be a parent, grandparent, nanny or sitter and should wear clothing that allows comfortable movement.

Little Dancer

For young dancers ages 3 to 4 years, the Little Dancer Class is designed as a program to address a child's developmental needs and create a fun dance experience.

Each session starts with activities such as bending, stretching and moving and progresses to locomotor movements including marching, galloping and jumping. Children also focus on learning to follow directions and dance as part of a group. Individual expression is encouraged as each child learns to use his/her body.

Creative Movement

MYB's Creative Movement classes are designed specifically for the early development of physical motion, rhythm, and coordination of 4 and 5 year olds. Children are guided through exercises and begin to develop a sense of poise and confidence. At the same time, they are encouraged to explore their own creative expression of music and dance movement.

The use of props such as scarves, fans, and balls, makes this a fun and playful experience while introducing the children to the social skills of group dynamics, self-control, and listening.

TUITION & REGISTRATION

Tuition for each 8-class session is \$140. Registration is not complete until a registration form, together with the \$60 non-refundable deposit or the full tuition payment for the session, has been received in the office. *Please note: All tuition is non-refundable and non-transferrable between students and/or sessions after the start of each session. Full payment for each session is due as scheduled but no later than the first day of class. Students with outstanding balances risk being automatically withdrawn after the first class.*

NOTE: Enrollment in successive sessions is not guaranteed.

Students are enrolled on a first come, first served basis once payment has been received.

UNIFORMS

Dance With Me (Girls and Boys): Loose comfortable clothing, socks or bare feet. Long hair secured and no jewelry.

Little Dancer: Solid color leotard (no attached skirt), pink tights, pink ballet shoes.

Creative Movement: Long-sleeved leotard (Capezio TB135), color – purple; pink tights (Capezio 1815C - color: BPK), pink ballet shoes.

Boys: White T-shirt, black tights, white socks, white shoes.
