## **Instruction & Contact**

I understand that in order to provide the student with quality instruction, the use of hands on contact is a vital component to aid in the learning of proper body alignment, turn-out, and placement.

## **Liability & Medical Consent**

I agree that I will not hold Maryland Youth Ballet (hereafter referred to as "MYB"), or any MYB faculty member, other employee, or contractor, liable for injuries sustained or illness contracted by the student during the attendance of classes, rehearsals or any related functions. This includes any and all online video classes, instruction, and other learning experiences provided by MYB.

**Students with severe or life-threatening medical conditions (meaning the student may require professional medical intervention and health needs beyond hydration or rest) must have a guardian present during the entirety of class.**

I agree that the use of the website shall be at my own risk and MYB is not liable for any interruption of transmission, any bugs, viruses, trojan horses or the like, which may be transmitted to and through the website.

I agree that this accident waiver and general release of liability shall be broadly construed to provide a release and waiver to the maximum extent permissible under applicable law.

I authorize MYB to call 911 for emergency treatment for my child on my behalf if I am not able to be reached. I further release MYB from all liabilities for injuries or damages arising out of personal injury of any kind.

## **Tuition Payments & Refunds - Early Dance**

Tuition listed is for each 8-class session plus a non-refundable registration fee up to \$25. A minimum non-refundable deposit of \$50 is required for each desired session. Tuition is payable in full at the time of registration. If not paid in full at registration, automatic installment payments must be set-up with a credit/debit card. Installment payments cannot be canceled; however, payments can be made in person with cash prior to the scheduled due date. If your balance due is more than 10 days late, you risk your child being automatically withdrawn from the enrolled session(s). Accounts 7 days late will incur a \$45 late fee.

You are responsible for the full tuition for the session(s) for which you have registered your child, unless withdrawn 48 hours prior to the start of the enrolled session(s). Withdrawals must be made through email in order to be processed. Please note: Refunds for any money paid above the non-refundable deposit(s) and fees (including Registration Fee, late fees and returned check fees) will only be issued if proper withdrawal procedures are followed.

**NOTE: After the start of your child's classes, you are responsible for the entire tuition balance whether or not your child continues to attend MYB during any remaining portion of their enrollment.**

## **Tuition Payments & Refunds - Introductory Division**

I understand that tuition is payable in full at the time of registration with a credit/debit card. If not paid in full at registration, automatic installment payments must be set-up with a credit/debit card. Installment payments cannot be canceled after the first three (3) weeks of my child's first day of class. Installment payments can be made through the Parent Portal at any time prior to the scheduled automatic payment date. Accounts 7 days late will incur a \$45 late fee.

I understand that I am responsible for the full tuition for the entire year in which I am registering my child, unless they withdraw within the first three (3) weeks of my child's first day of class or during the second grace period offered January 1-15. Withdrawals must be made in writing, emailed to the registrar, prior to the start of classes or during one of the aforementioned withdrawal grace periods.

Prior to and during the first three (3) weeks from the child's first day of class, all amounts paid for tuition are refundable (prorated) minus the non-refundable deposit (\$100) and any fees (including the registration fee, late fees and returned check fees). If withdrawing in January, only a flat prorated amount for tuition covering classes February-May will be refunded.

I understand that after the first three (3) weeks of my child's classes, I am responsible for the entire tuition balance whether or not my child continues to attend MYB during any remaining portion of their enrollment until the January grace period and/or thereafter. After the first three (3) weeks from the beginning of my child's first day of class and/or after January 15, all amounts paid or required to be paid for tuition and fees are non-refundable and non-cancelable.
